DECISION

This is an application by Joseph Taylor for an On-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 39, Marine Parade, Napier, and known as Spa Hotel.


The general nature of the event is International Latin Dance Festival

Pursuant to s 208 of the Act, I grant the applicant a waiver from filing the application within the required time. The applicant was unaware of the period from 20th December to 15th January being defined as days that are not working days, and I further consider that the neglect was not wilful, and I acknowledge that all reporting agencies have filed their reports without objections.

I am satisfied as to the matters I must have regard as set out in s142 of the Act, and grant the applicant a Special Licence subject to the conditions of the special licence 30/SP/4122/2017 attached to and forming part of this decision.

The licence may issue immediately.
