**DECISION**

This is an application by Michael George Baker for an On-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 55, Coote Road, Napier, and known as "Old Napier Prison".


The general nature of the event is Pre-wedding celebrations and mock shackling.

There being no matters raised in opposition to this application I shall deal with the matter on the papers. Pursuant to s 213(2) of the Act, I exempt the holder of the licence from appointing a manager as I am satisfied that Michael Baker will manage the conduct of the supply of alcohol pursuant to the licence.

I am satisfied as to the matters I must have regard as set out in s142 of the Act, and grant the applicant a Special Licence subject to the conditions of the special licence 30/SP/4139/2017 attached to and forming part of this decision.

The licence may issue immediately.
