DECISION

This is an application by **the Partnership of Susan Jane Potter and Sandra Elizabeth Taylor** for an Off-licence in respect of premises situated at 10, Denholm Road, Napier and known as "Hawkes Bay in a Box".

The general nature of the business undertaken is that of a remote seller


The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly I shall deal with the matter on the papers.

Pursuant to s.208 of the Act I waive the requirement for the times at which the public notices must be published. These were published prior to the deposit of the application, but as no enquiries or requests for inspection of the application were forthcoming I consider this neglect to have had no detrimental affect to the outcome of the application, and I am satisfied that the neglect was not wilful.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard as set out in s.105 of the Act and grant the applicant an Off-licence subject to the terms and conditions of the Off-licence 30/OFF/1259/2017 attached to and forming part of this decision.

The licence may issue immediately.
