DECISION

This is an application by **Yong Sheng Limited** for the renewal with variation of an Off-licence in respect of premises situated at 130, Kennedy Road, Marewa, Napier, known as "Marewa 4 Square".

The general nature of the business undertaken is that of a Grocery Store

The applicant seeks to vary the conditions of the licence as follows:

1. To alter the trading hours described on the licence as follows:

Proposed new hours: ".....Monday to Sunday, 7.00am to 8.00pm"

The licence shall also be amended to include the compulsory conditions of the Act

2. To include the requirement for the provision of free drinking water to be available during tastings.
3. To include the description of the alcohol area, such condition shall not apply for 6 weeks from the date of issue of the licence.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly I shall deal with the matter on the papers.


In an e-mail dated 5th October 2017 from the solicitor acting for the applicant, the hours of operation were changed from that of the public notice. Following this protracted administrative process, of no fault of the applicant, I issue a waiver pursuant to s208 for this slight anomaly in the public notified hours.

Furthermore, owing to the lateness of the conclusion of the renewal process and issue of the replacement licence and renewal certificate, I accept the submission from the solicitor in a letter dated 5th October 2017, and allow the late filing of the application for renewal of the present licence until 12th October 2017.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act, and grant the renewal of the licence with the variations until 13th October 2017, that being three years after the period for which the licence was last renewed, and authorise the issue of a notice of renewal and replacement licence 30/OFF/1213/2014 subject to the terms and conditions of the Off-licence, attached to, and forming part of, this decision.

The licence and renewal notice may issue immediately.
