**RESERVED DECISION OF THE NAPIER DISTRICT LICENSING
COMMITTEE**

1. Application

Karen Matata made the application on the prescribed form received on 24 June 2020. The applicant intends to use the certificate at 'Tamatea Pak n Save' (Supermarket Style OFF-licence).

The applicant has 8 years experience at this supermarket and previously held a certificate before letting it lapse.

The application included the applicant's qualifications and evidence attesting to the applicant's suitability to hold a certificate.

The applicant has attained the relevant License Controller Qualification and has not incurred any convictions.

2. Decision Making

In considering this application for a manager's certificate the licensing committee had regard to the following criteria under section 222 of the Act.

- (a) *the applicant's suitability to be a manager:*
- (b) *any convictions recorded against the applicant:*
- (c) *any experience, in particular recent experience, that the applicant has had in controlling any premises for which a licence was in force:*

- (d) *any relevant training, in particular recent training, that the applicant has undertaken and evidence that the applicant holds the prescribed qualification required under [section 218](#):*
- (e) *any matters dealt with in any report made under [section 220](#).*

3 Reporting Agencies

The following reports were received under section 220 of the Act and taken into account during the decision.

3.1 Police – No opposition noted within report received 7 July 2020.

3.2 Licensing Inspector – Full report assessing **Karen Matata**'s credentials against the Acts criteria. The inspector is satisfied that the applicant has the necessary knowledge to hold the certificate.

The inspector concludes that the grant of the certificate is supported.

4 Conclusion

Based on the evidence provided to me within the application and statutory reports I conclude that **Karen Matata** meets the criteria to be granted a Manager's Certificate in accordance with the Act.

5 Decision

Accordingly the application for manager's certificate is **Approved** for issue for a period of one year.
