IN THE MATTER of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012
AND
IN THE MATTER of an application by **Juan Raubenheimer** for a Manager's Certificate pursuant to section 219 of the Act.

The manager's certificate application (MC4099) had no objections filed and no matters of opposition raised under section 220 reports, therefore the matter was considered by the Napier District Licensing Commissioner in accordance with sections 221, 222 and 223 of the Act.

RESERVED DECISION OF THE NAPIER DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

1. Application

Juan Raubenheimer made the application on the prescribed form received on the 24 June 2020. The applicant intends using the certificate at 'Tamatea Pak 'n' Save' (Supermarket Style Off-licence), where the applicant has worked for over 24 months.

The application included evidence of obtaining the necessary License Controller Qualification and attesting to their experience and skills. The applicant declared they have no convictions.

2. Decision Making

In considering this application for a manager's certificate the licensing committee had regard to the following criteria under section 222 of the Act.

- (a) *the applicant's suitability to be a manager:*
- (b) *any convictions recorded against the applicant:*
- (c) *any experience, in particular recent experience, that the applicant has had in controlling any premises for which a licence was in force:*
- (d) *any relevant training, in particular recent training, that the applicant has undertaken and evidence that the applicant holds the prescribed qualification required under [section 218](#):*
- (e) *any matters dealt with in any report made under [section 220](#).*

3 Reporting Agencies

The following reports were received under section 220 of the Act and taken into account during the decision.

3.1 Police – No opposition within report dated 7 July 2020.

3.2 Licensing Inspector – Full report assessing **Juan Raubenheimer's** credentials against the Acts criteria. The inspector concludes that the application is complete, in all aspects appears to meet the criteria of section 222 of the Act to hold a manager's certificate and recommends that the Certificate be approved subject to an undertaking being annotated on the certificate limiting the use to an off-licence as well as a current work visa.

4 Conclusion

Based on the evidence provided to me within the application and statutory reports I conclude that **Juan Raubenheimer** meets the criteria to hold a Managers Certificate under the Act.

5 Decision

Accordingly the application is **Approved** for issue for a period of one year and an annotation on the certificate limiting its use to an off style licence and provided the holder has a current work visa.
