RESERVED DECISION OF THE NAPIER DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

1. Application

Megan Muir made the application on the prescribed form received on the 6 October 2020. The applicant intends using the certificate at the 'Tamatea Pak'n Save' (Supermarket Style Off-licence), where the applicant has worked for around 8 months.

The application included evidence of obtaining the necessary License Controller Qualification and attesting to their experience and skills. The applicant declared they have no convictions apart from that discussed above.

2. Decision Making

In considering this application for a manager's certificate the licensing committee had regard to the following criteria under section 222 of the Act.

- (a) *the applicant's suitability to be a manager:*
- (b) *any convictions recorded against the applicant:*
- (c) *any experience, in particular recent experience, that the applicant has had in controlling any premises for which a licence was in force:*
- (d) *any relevant training, in particular recent training, that the applicant has undertaken and evidence that the applicant holds the prescribed qualification required under [section 218](#):*
- (e) *any matters dealt with in any report made under [section 220](#).*

3 Reporting Agencies

The following reports were received under section 220 of the Act and taken into account during the decision.

3.1 Police – No opposition within report dated 9 October 2020.

3.2 Licensing Inspector – Full report assessing **Megan Muir's** credentials against the Acts criteria.

The inspector notes the applicant has signed an undertaking limiting the use of the certificate to Off-licence premises due to the applicant's limited industry experience.

The inspector concludes that the application is complete, in all aspects appears to meet the criteria of section 222 of the Act to hold a managers certificate.

4 Conclusion

Based on the evidence provided to me within the application and statutory reports I conclude that **Megan Muir** meets the criteria to hold a Managers Certificate under the Act.

5 Decision

Accordingly the application is **Approved** for issue for a period of one year subject to an 'undertaking', as described above, being annotated to the certificate.
