

**DECISION NUMBER 1406/2020**

**IN THE MATTER** of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

**IN THE MATTER** of an application pursuant to section 136 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 by **AHURIRI HOSPITALITY LIMITED** for a Temporary Authority in respect of the premises at 10A West Quay, Ahuriri, Napier and currently known as 'Harbour View Restaurants and Functions Centre'.

**DECISION**

**1. Introduction**

This is an application by **AHURIRI HOSPITALITY LIMITED** for a Temporary Authority in respect of the premises situated at 10A West Quay, Ahuriri, Napier and currently known as 'Harbour View Restaurants and Functions Centre'.

The application comes about from a change of ownership and is required to allow the applicant to continue trading while the application for a new licence is processed by the Licensing Committee. This is the **first** Temporary Authority made by the applicant against the licence.

**2. Application**

The application is made against off-licence **030/ON/1334/2019** which has an expiry date of 15 October 2022.

The application was not advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received under section 103 of the Act. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers in accordance with sections 136 and 202(1) of the Act.

In considering the application for temporary authority the committee had regard to the object of the Act and reports furnished by Police and Inspector.

### 3. Reporting Agencies

The following reports were received under the Act.

**Police Report** – No opposition from Police.

**Licensing Inspector Report** – The inspector notes that the applicant is a private company with two directors and one shareholder.

The inspector concludes that the application is complete and meets the criteria of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The inspector recommends that the licence be issued subject to standard conditions.

I concur with the inspector's assessment.

### 4. Decision

Accordingly the application for a Temporary Licence is **Approved**, valid for 3 months from takeover date i.e. **28 September 2020** or when the Substantive Licence Application lodged by the applicant is determined, whichever is the sooner.

The Temporary Authority can be issued immediately and come into effect from the **28 September 2020** (date of settlement) with the standard conditions.
