**RESERVED DECISION OF THE NAPIER DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE**

**1. Application**

**Tiffany Wode** made the application on the prescribed form received on 3 December 2020. The applicant intends to use the certificate at 'Duke of Gloucester' (Tavern Style On-licence).

The applicant has experience working at these premises for over 11 months.

The application included the applicant's qualifications and evidence attesting to the applicant's suitability to hold a certificate. In a manager's certificate interview with the inspector he displayed suitable knowledge and understanding of the Act and host responsibility.

The applicant has attained the relevant License Controller Qualification and has not incurred any convictions.

**2. Decision Making**

In considering this application for a manager's certificate the licensing committee had regard to the following criteria under section 222 of the Act.

- (a) *the applicant's suitability to be a manager:*
- (b) *any convictions recorded against the applicant:*
  - (c) *any experience, in particular recent experience, that the applicant has had in controlling any premises for which a licence was in force:*
- (d) *any relevant training, in particular recent training, that the applicant has undertaken and evidence that the applicant holds the prescribed qualification required under [section 218](#):*
- (e) *any matters dealt with in any report made under [section 220](#).*

**3 Reporting Agencies**

The following reports were received under section 220 of the Act and taken into account during the decision.

**3.1 Police** – No opposition noted within report received 11 December 2020.

**3.2 Licensing Inspector** – Full report assessing **Tiffany Wode’s** credentials against the Acts criteria. The inspector has interviewed the applicant and is satisfied that the applicant has the necessary knowledge to hold the certificate.

The inspector concludes that the grant of the certificate is supported.

**4 Conclusion**

Based on the evidence provided to me within the application and statutory reports I conclude that **Tiffany Wode** meets the criteria to be granted a Managers Certificate in accordance with the Act.

**5 Decision**

Accordingly the application for manager’s certificate is **Approved** for issue for a period of one year.
