IN THE MATTER of an application by **Rachel Craig** for a Manager's Certificate pursuant to section 219 of the Act.

RESERVED DECISION OF THE NAPIER DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

1. Application

Rachel Craig made the application on the prescribed form received on the 17 March 2022. The applicant intends using the certificate at the 'Pak n Save Tamatea' (Supermarket Style Off-licence). The applicant has over nine months' experience in the industry.

The application included evidence of obtaining the necessary License Controller Qualification and attesting to their experience and skills. The applicant declared they have no convictions.

2. Decision Making

In considering this application for a manager's certificate the licensing committee had regard to the following criteria under section 222 of the Act.

- (a) *the applicant's suitability to be a manager:*
- (b) *any convictions recorded against the applicant:*
- (c) *any experience, in particular recent experience, that the applicant has had in controlling any premises for which a licence was in force:*
- (d) *any relevant training, in particular recent training, that the applicant has undertaken and evidence that the applicant holds the prescribed qualification required under [section 218](#):*
- (e) *any matters dealt with in any report made under [section 220](#).*

3 Reporting Agencies

The following reports were received under section 220 of the Act and taken into account during the decision.

3.1 Police – No opposition within report dated 4 April 2022.

3.2 Licensing Inspector – Full report assessing **Rachel Craig's** credentials against the Acts criteria.

The Inspector notes the applicant's limited experience in certain types of premises and records the applicant has signed an undertaking restricting use of the certificate to an Off-type licence. This is supported.

The inspector concludes that the application is complete, in all aspects appears to meet the criteria of section 222 of the Act to hold a manager's certificate.

4 Conclusion

Based on the evidence provided to me within the application and statutory reports I conclude that **Rachel Craig** meets the criteria to hold a Manager's Certificate under the Act.

5 Decision

Accordingly the application is **Approved** for issue for a period of one year subject to the undertaking endorsement on the certificate.
