RESERVED DECISION OF THE NAPIER DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

1. Application

Annemarie Myburgh made the application on the prescribed form received on the 7 April 2022. The applicant intends using the certificate with 'Pak n Save Tamatea' (Supermarket Style Off-licence). The applicant has over twelve months experience in the industry.

The application included evidence of obtaining the necessary License Controller Qualification and attesting to their experience and skills. The applicant declared they have no convictions.

2. Decision Making

In considering this application for a manager's certificate the licensing committee had regard to the following criteria under section 222 of the Act.

- (a) *the applicant's suitability to be a manager:*
- (b) *any convictions recorded against the applicant:*
- (c) *any experience, in particular recent experience, that the applicant has had in controlling any premises for which a licence was in force:*
- (d) *any relevant training, in particular recent training, that the applicant has undertaken and evidence that the applicant holds the prescribed qualification required under [section 218](#):*
- (e) *any matters dealt with in any report made under [section 220](#).*

3 Reporting Agencies

The following reports were received under section 220 of the Act and taken into account during the decision.

3.1 Police – No opposition within report.

3.2 Licensing Inspector – Full report assessing **Annemarie Myburgh’s** credentials against the Acts criteria.

The Inspector notes the applicant has signed an undertaking limiting the use of the certificate to an off type licence. This is endorsed.

The inspector concludes that the application is complete, in all aspects appears to meet the criteria of section 222 of the Act to hold a manager’s certificate.

4 Conclusion

Based on the evidence provided to me within the application and statutory reports I conclude that **Annemarie Myburgh** meets the criteria to hold a Managers Certificate under the Act.

5 Decision

Accordingly the application is **Approved** for issue for a period of one year and the undertaking being attached to the certificate.
