Public Petitions and Displays Policy

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidance for staff on public petitions and displays in the Napier Libraries.

Policy

1. The Napier Libraries be appropriate places to display material and petitions on current affairs and other matters of public interest.
2. The material, including petitions, may be displayed in a variety of formats, such as posters, notices, pamphlets, cartoons or books.
3. The libraries make available such space for the display as deemed appropriate and practical by the Library Manager at the time of the request.
4. Library staff do not promote any viewpoint on a display or a petition during the course of their duties.
5. In the case of petitions, the petitioner's name and address be included on every page.
6. The content of all displays of whatever type must be legal and any doubt as to the item's legibility be referred to the Chief Executive for approval for display.

Policy Review

The review timeframe for this policy will be no longer than every three years.
