

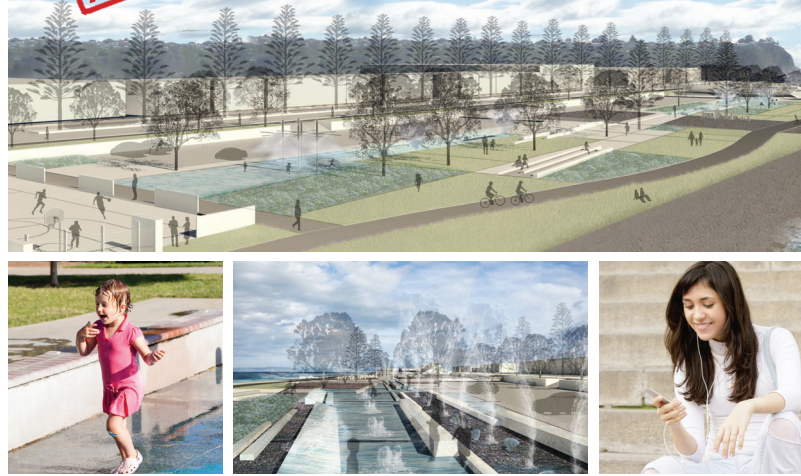
# THE BIG PICTURE MARINE PARADE 2013 & BEYOND

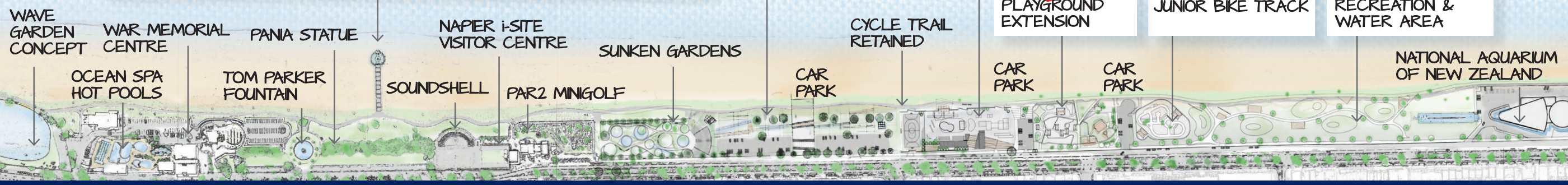
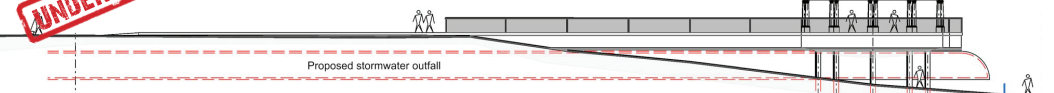

## Waterfront fun for all

Marine Parade is Napier’s playground. Ongoing development creates a waterfront wonderland for everyone to enjoy.

In the coming months it is proposed to redevelop Marineland, Sk8 Zone and the Sunken Gardens, with the addition of Napier Skate Park, the reef garden and an amphitheatre.

The reef garden will provide for an interactive water play and sculpture recreation area which will transition to a low level amphitheatre overlooking the Sunken Gardens. From here performance, outdoor cinema and other entertainment will be delivered to the Napier community and visitors from around the country and the world.

The Marineland site will be converted to a world-class skating facility, with an outdoor multi-sports arena for roller derby, basketball and futsal. A new café will provide refreshments and somewhere to watch the surrounding activities and enjoy the views.
