

## **Summary of Statement of Planning Evidence of Cameron James Drury on Behalf of Napier City Council Events Manager (NCC EM)**

1. NCC EM made submissions on provisions in the TEMP and LIGHT chapters.
2. While recommendations have been made by the Officer to accept some of the relief sought, my evidence provides planning analysis on the relief sought by NCC EM in relation to:
  - Removing the height control in (rule) TEMP-R2A(4) from applying to temporary buildings and structures,
  - Extending the time when light spill limitations would otherwise commence when temporary activities are undertaken on the Church Road Winery site,
  - Reducing the number of non-sporting temporary noise events per calendar year within the Stadium Zone as provided for under (rule) TEMP-R2(1)(a) from 10 to 6.
3. In short,
  - Compliance with yard setback and height in relation to boundary controls alone are sufficient to manage the effects of temporary buildings and structures,
  - On the basis that only 5 temporary events are permitted to occur per calendar year, it would seem reasonable to extend the time when light spill limitations would otherwise commence to enable better clean up and pack down,
  - Reducing the number of events that McClean Park can host is at odds with the purpose of McLean Park and will impact and limit the ability of the facility to host events,
  - There is still conflict between the STADZ and TEMP chapters, and decisions on the Officers recommendations on the TEMP chapter, or at least on (rule) TEMP-R2A(1)(a), should be deferred until they can be made alongside the STADZ Zone.
