The NCC need to be fully aware that if a stop bank is built along the Esk River on the true left side in the Esk Valley this will have the effect of forcing flood water along the land area East of SH 2 from the SH2, SH5 intersection right through Bayview to its south border. Any Stop bank built on the true left will require a stop bank to be built from the SH 2 ,SH5 intersection on the true right of the Esk river to the sea to protect Bayview. A case could be made that there should be a stop bank as mentioned above installed anyway to protect Bayview residents. Although not NCC responsibility the Esk river mouth needs re designing and widened greatly to allow flood water to exit the Esk valley rapidly.

Relief sought

Work with the Hastings District Co and the HBRC to implement Esk river flood protection improvements to protect Bayview residents /infrastructure etc from future flooding from the Esk river.
