

# Redclyffe Refuse Transfer Station

## Terms and Conditions of Use

1. Any person wishing to dispose of waste or deposit divertible material at the transfer station must comply with the terms and conditions as outlined below. Opening hours are as advertised on the Council's website and at entry to the site.
2. Charges are set annually and confirmed by Council as part of the Annual Plan process.
3. Entry to the transfer station is conditional upon the user abiding by directions given by notice, signage and staff or contractors of Council.
4. Any abusive, offensive and/or threatening language or behaviour towards Napier City Council staff and/or their Contractors may result in a trespass notice. This includes any unreasonable behaviour or action towards any Napier City Council staff and/or Contractor working for or on behalf of Napier City Council.
5. Payment for waste disposal must be made at the time of the dumping of waste in accordance with the approved Fees and Charges applicable to that transaction unless prior authorisation has been granted by holding an account with Council
6. It will be a condition of entry to the transfer station that vehicles and or trailers may be subject to random audits for the purpose of determining whether or not they contain material which is not accepted This includes but is not limited to:
  - a) paint
  - b) hazardous substances such as asbestos, batteries, agricultural and horticultural chemicals, solvents, fuels, household and commercial chemicals,
  - c) truck or heavy plant tyres,
  - d) sludges
  - e) electronic waste
7. Detection of material that does not comply with the terms and conditions for use of the transfer station may result in:
  - a) Refusal to accept that waste or load for disposal
  - b) A notice being issued against that person by the Council to prevent them from using the transfer station
  - c) Any other steps that may be taken by the Council in law.
8. Commercial volumes of recycling, or recycling collected as/from a commercial operation are not accepted in the recycling area. This facility is for residential quantities only.
9. No one shall remove or disturb any deposit of waste or diverted material, or remove any article or material of any kind from the transfer station, unless prior authorisation to do so has been granted by the Council's Manager Environmental Solutions
10. Council reserves the right to trespass any person who acts unlawfully, in a manner offensive to staff, contractors or other customers, or creates dangers to themselves or other persons without delay.
11. No one shall light any fire upon or near the transfer station without the express permission of the Council.
