<p><i>Smart Growth</i></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Infrastructure planning is aligned with land use planning to facilitate efficient and affordable development in identified growth areas</li> <li>2. Vibrant and sustainable Napier CBD with a mix of complementary activities and public spaces that encourages inner city / fringe city living</li> <li>3. Economic activity and innovation is supported and enabled in appropriate locations</li> <li>4. Significant infrastructure which supports economic growth, including the Port, Airport, Expressway and railway, is enabled and protected</li> <li>5. Housing supply and choice meets demand and reflects the demographics of Napier's community</li> <li>6. Rural production in the Heretaunga Plains is enabled and protected</li> <li>7. Regulation is clear and appropriate to achieve the strategic objectives</li> </ol>
<p><i>Quality Design</i></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Quality, high amenity and healthy environments to live, work and play</li> <li>2. Napier's transport network optimises connectivity, public health and safety, and encourages active and public transport modes</li> <li>3. <p><i>Environmental Excellence</i></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Sustainable design is integrated into the design of new developments</li> <li>2. Ecological assets and urban waterways are maintained and enhanced</li> <li>3. Napier's coastal environment is recognised and protected from inappropriate use and development</li> <li>4. Plant selection recognises Napier's environmental and cultural context</li> </ol>
<p><i>Resilient Napier</i></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Risk to people and property from natural hazards is avoided or mitigated</li> <li>2. Vulnerability of the community to hazards is reduced</li> <li>3. Natural systems are maintained and restored</li> <li>4. Infrastructure design considers long term risk of natural hazards and climate change</li> </ol>
<p><i>Our People, Our Stories</i></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Napier's distinctive character, culture, heritage, and landscapes are recognised, celebrated and enhanced</li> <li>2. The protection, management and conservation of Napier's Art Deco heritage is achieved</li> <li>3.
